### Footnotes

ANALOGY set the pace along the inside, repulsed a bid from two rivals on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to prevail. JACKS GENES chased the pace along the inside into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while proving best of the rest. CATIRA VALEN tracked the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to gain the show. DON'T TELL LOU rank early, saved ground and failed to menace. PURE ANTICIPATION was not a factor. HOOCHIE KOO rated off the pace, made a run three wide to reach near even terms for command on the far turn, then tired. FORMAL RUCKUS chased the pace off the rail, made a run to try ANALOGY on the far turn, then faltered in the drive. ONE HOT TOMATO was outrun after breaking slowly.
