DIAMOND BRACELET vied for the lead along the inside and held on well for the place. MYSTICAL AFFAIR vied for the lead into the stretch and weakened. GREAT AROMA jostled between rivals at the start, chased the pace into the stretch but couldn't gain late along the inside. WONDER BULL reserved racing along the rail, lacked a rally. TIGRINA bumped with GREAT AROMA at the start and was outrun while racing four wide.
