LADY STARS tracked the leaders to the turn, angled four wide, loomed boldly outside to take over leaving the quarter pole and drew away under urging to prove best. CUPID SEASON unhurried early, swung out for the stretch run, and closed to be up for the place while no match for the winner. MYSTICAL BEAUTY vied for the lead off the rail outside FUNNY FARM, and gave way late stretch. ROYAL DOVE passed tiring rivals after trailing. THUNDER BABE stalked the pace to the turn, moved into contention three wide outside MYSTICAL BEAUTY and weakened in the drive. FUNNY FARM vied for the lead inside MYSTICAL BEAUTY and tired turning for home.
