Footnotes

DOC'S HONEY well placed racing along the hedge, eased outside TUSCANY LIGHT in the stretch, rallied to catch that rival nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear. TUSCANY LIGHT vied for the lead along the hedge, drew clear in the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final sixteenth. SILET reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn, angled outside the leaders for the drive and closed to be up for the show. KATHY LEE G. allowed to settle, rallied along the hedge to reach contention in the stretch, then flattened out. SHERINGHAM LADY unhurried early, raced four wide on the far turn, swung out for the drive and had no late response. GO HELEN GO outrun early, passed tired rivals without threatening. RAISE THE LEVEL rated off the pace, made a run four wide on the far turn to reach contention, then tired in the drive. WINNIEDAWHALE was never a factor. SHAHALIE LAKE chased the leaders three wide into the far turn and faltered. SINN FREE vied for the lead from the outside to nearing the stretch, then gave way. MS. RUSSIAN CAT vied for the lead between horses to the far turn and faded. MISS BO BLUSH was done early.
