NAN'S ROSE rated off the pace three wide, gained command late stretch, and drew clear under urging. SHE'SFULLOFHOPE void of early speed, circled the field five wide on the final turn and closed fast to be up for the place. STORMY SKY set the pace along the inside and gave way in late stretch. PROUD MEGAN showed no speed early, four wide on the final turn, lacked a late response. WILD BUT WORTH IT stalked the pace off the rail and weakened late. ICANSEECLEARLY raced in midpack without threatening. GOOD O VALENTINE had an early brief lead while saving ground and tired. SEDONA SUNRISE was through early after breaking slowly.
