Footnotes

SPECIAL SONG quickly cleared the field on the chute for inside position, rated the pace two deep through the backstretch, widened on the turn and maintained well with moderate hand urging. RO MEGA settled off the pace in the four path, started a drive into the turn, reached place a furlong away and finished well while no threat to the winner. CHECKPOINTCHARLIE chased the pace from the three path, reached the number two spot nearing the quarter pole though relinquished that position midstretch. CRIMSON STREAK showed no speed off the rail, bid three wide nearing the quarter pole then finished evenly toward the rail. CODE TAKER, well back, was never a factor though passed tiring rivals outside. CODE MONEY pressured the pace from the inside but lacked further in the stretch. CUNAGUARO was not a factor. NUEVO SEVILLE gave close early chase then faded nearing the quarter pole.
