Footnotes

ALL KEYED UP stalked the pace, eased out on the far turn, rallied to gain a slim lead from SUCCESS RATE inside the eighth pole, then was all out to prevail. SQUARE DANCER reserved racing along the rail, was checked when trapped in behind a wall of horses on the far turn, angled out for the stretch run and closed to dead heat with SUCCESS RATE. The latter, stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over on the far turn and edged clear, then responded when headed by ALL KEYED UP inside the eighth pole but was outgamed to the wire while finishing on even terms for the place. BOY OF SUMMER unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run and rallied while unable to catch the top ones. HOW ABOUT PEACE pinched back soon after the start, advanced four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then tired. LUCKY SHOT set the pace along the rail to midway of the far turn and faltered. HIGH RED STAR chased the pace into the far turn, then faded. MR. J G was outrun.
