QUARTERMAIN settled early, began a steady advance after a half, roused for the drive, steady gain to the wire, up final stride. SENOR CASTRICO stalked the early leader through legit early fractions, took over from the outside late in the final turn, shook clear, maintained a daylight advantage until late, nipped at the wire while inside the winner. JOROPO void of early foot, saved ground through the final turn, steered out a bit for the drive, rallied through traffic, up late for the show while between rivals. BE MY FRANKENSTEIN in a bit tight at the start, settled off the pace, went one paced throughout while toward the inside. BLUE BUSINESS four wide through the first turn, continued to race on the outside in the run up the backstretch, five wide through the second bend, displayed a modest amount of late interest down the middle of the strip to earn the dead heat for the fourth spot. DYNAMIC DUKE sprinted clear the opening quarter to set a quick opening split, continued to show the way up the backstretch and into the second turn, gave way when headed by the winner late in that bend. BABY MAXWELL lacked speed, failed to rally. INAGOTABLE dwelt at the start, four wide late in the final turn while remaining back, never close. SOUL OF THE NORTH forwardly placed for a half, stopped.
