ANOTHER OPINION reserved after being bumped and checked at the start, angled three wide entering the stretch and rallied under pressure to draw clear late. DEVILS TEA chased the pace, moved to take over leaving the turn and continued on with good courage to be clearly second best while unable to stay with the winner late. COUNT ON KRIS unhurried early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. HECTOR'S WORLD well placed racing along the rail, tired in the drive. WILD EYE BILL angled in to make the pace along the inside, then faltered leaving the turn. SWEDISH SON was no factor after breaking poorly. FIRST CAT lunged just after the start bumping ANOTHER OPINION soundly and was outrun. HE'LL BE THERE showed early foot three wide and faded.
