SARA'S SUCCESS rated off the pace, advanced three wide on the far turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. SLUICE unhurried early, bumped with DANCE TOUR in early stretch and closed well to be up for the place. UPTOWN ANTHEM made the pace along the rail into the stretch and gave way. MULTIPLICITY rank in the early going, prompted the pace into the far turn and weakened. LEONA'S HOPE failed to menace. NELSON'S LADY raced three wide and was not a factor. CHEEKS bobbed at the start, was steadied entering the first turn, raced up close along the rail, then was tiring when she bobbed again on the far turn. DANCE TOUR steadied when caught in tight racing into the first turn, chased the pace along the inside, then was tiring when she bumped with SLUICE in early stretch and faltered. WIMAUMA MAMA checked from tight quarters soon after the start and was outrun.
