GUTS TO GLORY stalked the pace from the outside, ranged up in the three path to challenge turning for home, wore foe down, kicked clear the final furlong while being kept to task. EXCLUSIVE FORCE lacked early foot, roused while also racing in the three path exiting the bend, proved no match for the winner the final furlong, clear for the place. MALIBU WAVE moved up inside to set the pace just after a quarter, dueled into the lane inside the winner, weakened the final furlong. SAILING CLEAR settled off the pace and the rail, lacked a response in the drive. EL SPEEDO broke well, showed the way off the inside, chased the leader through the turn, gave way in the drive. EL KIWI last away, never a threat. I CAN AND I WILL finished early, raced wide, finished well back.
