STRANGE BUT TRUE bumped with SOUTH KEY at the start, pressed the pace outside MAGNIFICENT DANCER, moved to take over at the eighth and was fully extended to prevail. UNITY CALLING chased the pace along the rail, steadied when caught in tight entering the turn, made a run to reach near even terms at the top of the stretch and continued on with good courage while being edged to the wire. MAGNIFICENT DANCER set the pace under pressure racing off the rail to nearing the eighth pole and gave way. MEDIEVAL BIRD chased the leaders four wide into the stretch and weakened. SOUTH KEY rated off the pace after bumping with STRANGE BUT TRUE at the start, raced four wide around the turn and lacked a rally. MISTY FROLIC off slowly, was not a factor. MISS ABERDEEN raced three wide and tired. KELLON'S FIRST raced in striking position to midway of the turn and faltered.
