BUCK FOR PAR bobbled at the start, advanced along the rail to reach contention in the stretch, then weakened. LACY LADY chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. GENTLE BREEZE LOLA was no factor while racing three wide. DOC'S TREASURE was through early. LILS GOLDEN GEM was outrun while racing four wide.
