TIGRINA chased the pace off the rail, rallied to catch SWEET DREAMS BABY at the seventy yard pole and drew clear. SWEET DREAMS BABY sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, made the pace to inside the sixteenth pole and was outfinished. APRIL BEAUTY unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn and closed to gain the show. EAGLE CAT outrun early, passed tired rivals without threatening. SASSARI rated in striking position off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. BRIEFDIAMOND was outrun. PRINCESSOFKALITHEA showed early foot and faltered. VICTORY PARADE stumbled at the start, was through early and eased in the final eighth. SUMMER'S GIFT chased the pace to nearing the stretch, stopped and was eased in the final eighth.
