Footnotes

ALEXANDRIA broke to the inside, chased the pace along the rail, rallied to gain a slim lead leaving the turn and was fully extended to prevail. ANNA'S CAT chased the pace three wide, made a run at the lead through the stretch and was just edged to the wire. SHE IS RAGING chased the leaders four wide into the stretch, then was gaining on the top ones at the finish while racing greenly through the stretch. FOUR TWENTY SEVEN broke awkwardly, then was caught in tight inside ALEXANDRIA soon after, saved ground around the turn, eased out in midstretch and finished willingly. LADY LOOT showed speed off the rail to inside the eighth pole and weakened. MS. PROTOCOL raced five wide around the turn and tired. RAVEN HALO was no factor after breaking slowly. TERIYAKI TWIST trailed. The rider of FOUR TWENTY SEVEN lodged an objection against the rider of ALEXANDRIA for alleged interference after the start. The claim of foul was not allowed.
