Footnotes

RAINBOW CRUISE raced well reserved to set the pace inside, was pressured past the five sixteenths pole, dug in under steady left hand encouragement from the head of the lane and lasted well when his rider switched sticks the closing yards. SPOTLIGHT SCAM stalked the pace off the rail, took aim inside through the final turn, eased out entering the stretch, drew close to the winner but hung at that ones outside flank the closing yards. THE CAT RULES stalked the pace three wide, took aim from the five sixteenths pole but lost ground entering the stretch and leveled off. EL COBRE rated just off the pace inside, started a drive nearing the three eighths pole, forced his way out making light contact with Cat Daddy in the upper stretch but flattened out the remainder. EL TABRAWY, shuffled back at the start, saved ground to the five sixteenths pole, angled out but had no rally widest. CAT DADDY rated off the pace two deep, eased out from the five sixteenths pole, was brushed lightly into the lane and leveled off from there. MORGANS BOY was outrun.
