### Footnotes

MINISTREL LISA stalked the pace off the rail, then rallied under pressure to be up late while being bumped by SANSANNAH. SANSANNAH unhurried early, circled rivals four wide around the far turn to reach contention, then rallied inside MINISTREL LISA to just miss while being knocked into that rival nearing the wire. STARSHIP CUTIE set the pace along the rail to deep stretch, then drifted out late knocking SANSANNAH into MINISTREL LISA and was edged to the wire. APPELLA'S WONDER rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and finished willingly. IN CONTROL LORETTA outrun early, raced four wide around the far turn and closed to ground late without threatening. SUCH A SWEET GIRL failed to menace. MISSEQUINS tired from good position. HEY DIRTY FACE fractious in the gate, was not a factor. PERFECT BERRY reserved racing along the inside, steadied on the far turn and faltered. VITAL VICTORY chased the pace into the far turn, then faded. THE RIDER OF SANSANNAH LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF MINISTREL LISA FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN DEEP STRETCH. THE CLAIM OF FOUL WAS NOT ALLOWED.
