### Footnotes

B B'S SONG showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then drew clear when roused. PIZZI'S PRIDE rated off the pace after breaking a step slowly, angled out for the drive and closed with a mild response to be up for the place. SUNNY EXCHANGE reserved early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. COMPRISE pressed the pace outside B B'S SONG to nearing the stretch, then gave way. THREE POINT TICKET off a step slowly, tracked the pace three wide around the turn and tired. STORM SLEW off slowly, tracked the pace along the inside to past midway of the turn, then faltered.
