### Footnotes

TOOK IT FROM HIM chased the pace, rallied to take over at the quarter pole and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to hold sway. BROKE BY NOON outrun after being steadied at the start, raced three wide around the far turn and closed well for the place. MR POSTMAN unhurried early, passed tired rivals for the show. THEPOSSE'SAFTERME checked along the inside entering the first turn, saved ground into the stretch and gave way. ASKARI set the pace along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then tired. BLACK TIE SPIRIT tracked the pace into the stretch, then faltered. EL COBRE steadied in traffic on the first turn and was not a factor. AU LEAF was through after a half mile. OMEGA RISING tracked the pace into the far turn, then faded. GABLES LIGHT was outrun after being pinched back in the early going. The rider of THEPOSSE'SAFTERME lodged an objection against the rider of TOOK IT FROM HIM for alleged interference entering the first turn. The claim of foul was not allowed.
