AMBITIOUS THIEF stalked the pace off the rail, started her bid leaving the three eighths pole, steadily closed the gap to catch the pacesetter inside the eighth pole and dug in determinedly to inch ahead nearing the wire. GIANT'S KISSES settled back inside, bid toward the final turn, eased out through the upper stretch and closed steadily to catch the pacesetter for place. TIGER ON THE GREEN became fractious unseating her rider in the post parade, broke outward making contact with Sterling Melody, pulled herself toward contention on the front stretch, stalked the leaders three wide the opening turn, moved to the lead inside the nine sixteenths pole, was soon clear, pressured from the top of the stretch, dug in to the winners challenge a furlong away then reluctantly yielded the closing yards. PASADORA, unhurried inside, bid at the rail leaving the three eighths pole and finished evenly. STERLING MELODY, bumped at the start, raced unhurriedly inside, made a mild bid while angling outward on the final turn then leveled off widest. RUNAWAY FUHR, off the pace outside, weakened.
