JIMANATOR stalked the pace, angled four wide on the far turn, rallied to engage MAMBO MEISTER leaving the far turn, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and prevailed. MAMBO MEISTER stalked the pace three wide, moved to gain a slim lead while still in hand nearing the quarter pole, responded when challenged by JIMANATOR, then dueled with that rival to deep stretch and was outgamed to the wire. STIMULUS PLAN unhurried early, swung wide for the stretch run, then passed tired rivals to be up for the show while unable to keep pace with the top ones. SKY VENTURE moved up leaving the first turn to press the pace between horses to the quarter pole, then tired. GENERALISSIMO saved ground and failed to menace. TELLUM BERTO quickly moved to the fore, set the pace under pressure along the rail to nearing the quarter pole, then faltered. SHELLBACK stalked the pace four wide to midway of the far turn and faded. FLATTER THIS was never a factor.
