Footnotes

PUT IT BACK TWENTY vied for the lead outside UNDER CONTRACT into the stretch, then was drawing clear when he drifted in a bit at the sixteenth pole. UNDER CONTRACT vied for the lead along the inside, then couldn't stay with the winner, steadied at the sixteenth pole and just saved the place. WESLINN bumped and checked from between rivals after breaking slowly, saved ground and closed with a belated rally for the show. HAPS ALPHABET SOUP steadied soon after the start, tracked the pace three wide into the stretch and had no late response. FOREST GRINDER bumped and steadied between rivals at the start, showed early foot and tired. BEACHMONT FASHION bumped with FOREST GRINDER at the start, chased the pace along the inside, was steadied to avoid running up on the leader on the turn, angled out for the drive and faltered. SLEWSMARTSTRIKE was no factor after bumping with WESLINN at the start. KING MACHO was outrun. The rider of UNDER CONTRACT lodged an objection against the rider of PUT IT BACK TWENTY for alleged interference at the sixteenth pole. The claim of foul was not allowed.
