GRAND CASH dropped well back to save ground, made his bid into the final turn, swerved six wide near the quarter pole, advanced steadily through the stretch and got the lead the final strides. EL COMMODORE rated the pace inside, contested a short lead through the final turn, recovered clear territory at the top of the lane, held on well to deep stretch though was outfinished the closing strides. NINEINTHENINE rated back off the hedge, started his drive leaving the three eighths pole, entered the stretch five wide and finished well for show. BEAR'S ROCKET rated close saving ground, bid near the hedge at the five sixteenths pole and dueled close to deep stretch before leveling off. GULF RUCKUS stalked the pace in the three path, bid three wide into the final turn and continued in close chase to deep stretch before flattening stride. CONCORDE'S FURY, well back inside, eased out leaving the quarter pole and bid mildly through the lane. MARCELLO settled close in the three path to the final turn, dropped back through the turn and had nothing left in the stretch. DUCDUC rated off the pace in the four path, gave close chase on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. STRONG STAR saved ground off the pace then faded. A CENTURIAN stalked the pace two deep, gave close chase on the final turn then weakened in the stretch.
