MARTINI MADNESS chased the pace off the rail, rallied to take over in the stretch and edged away under pressure. BOB'S PLACE showed speed along the inside into the stretch, then couldn't stay with the winner while clearly best of the rest. EHECATL rated off the pace, passed tired rivals for the show. RINUNCIO BOBO tracked the leaders four wide around the turn and tired. RIOJANO chased the pace three wide around the turn, then faltered. INDIRECTLY A. P. tracked the pace along the rail, then steadied from tight quarters nearing the eighth pole and failed to recover. RAGING DAOUST off slowly, failed to menace. BEA TOP QUALITY was not a factor. STARSHIP SILVERADO trailed.
