STRONG FIRE forwardly placed along the inside, continued to race behind the wall of leaders early turn under patient handling, squeezed to along the rail to challenge turning for home, drew well clear under steady handling. BAD NEWS CAPTAIN off a step slow, swung out to be five wide turning for home, finished willingly down the center of the strip to finish willingly and to be getting to the winner. WHATSUPNOTMUCH cleared toward the inside soon after the start, vied through the turn in the two path, allowed the winner the inside turning for home, could not keep up with that one or contain the runner up, all out to hold the show. MY FRIEND RALPH forwardly placed, vied in the four path while between rivals turn, outfinished for the show late. FAST STACK forwardly placed early while outside, vied five wide through the turn, weakened in the drive. SANDALYE with the pace while three wide and between horses in the turn, gave way in the drive. EEK off slow, sluggish, fell further back, trailed home.
