IMAREALGUY sprinted clear to the first turn, eased back off Good O Friday into the backstretch, overtook that rival when ready before six furlongs, drew off and was not threatened thereafter. SPEED AND HEART steadied back along the inside on the opening bend, angled wide into the stretch and finished best of all. GOOD O FRIDAY took command from inside Imarealguy on the opening turn, could not resist that rival when challenged and gradually weakened. CRAFTMANSHIP passed tired ones. KING GLACKEN was no factor. MEAN KISSER lagged early, made a mild run on the second turn but failed to sustain the bid. NODOUBLE TODAY tired. RUNNIN TO THE BAR prompted the pace and gradually weakened. HOPETOWN HERO stopped badly and was eased to the wire.
