BLUE GRASS MUSIC taken in hand at the start, raced within striking distance while saving ground, continued inside through the second turn, eased out to be three wide when clear entering the straight, challenged on the outside with a furlong remaining and proved best under brisk handling. KLUKI got clear and to the inside, set a modest pace in hand, responded when challenged in the drive, proved stubborn to the end while drifting out slightly in the late going. CASA TUA firmly rated outside the runner up, challenged between that foe and the winner with a furlong remaining, bothered slightly late when KLUKI drifted out, outfinished. WIKI WIKI fell back off the pace, raced in traffic while under firm restraint in the first turn, mid pack in the run up the backstretch, traffic again late in the final turn, moved out for room, no threat to the top three at the wire. FLY AWAY MARIJA void of speed while angling to the inside past the wire the first time, continued to save ground, improved position up the hedge in the drive while also not a serious threat. SHEZMYTEN back and off the inside, never dangerous. SAMANTHA G in a bit tight at the start, raced outside, failed to menace. NEED YOU TONIGHT prompted the pace three wide, gave way.
