Footnotes

SIBERCRASHER unhurried early, was steadied along the inside at the top of the stretch, angled out and rallied under pressure to be up late. TROOPER RED allowed to settle, rallied three wide on the far turn, took over at the eighth pole and continued on with good courage while being edged late. SUNNY APPROVAL reserved off the pace, angled out in early stretch and closed to be up for the show. RUNNING RYAN rated off the pace, angled in leaving the far turn and rallied to reach even terms for the lead approaching the eighth pole, then weakened. THE KAISER outrun early, failed to menace while passing tired rivals. VIVA PENTELICUS set the pace after bobbling at the start, moved to the inside after clearing ATIBA racing down the backstretch, then gave way in the stretch run. ATIBA prompted the pace inside VIVA PENTELICUS, then tired after entering the far turn. HOLMDEL chased the pace into the far turn and faltered. TRACKING (GB) steadied when caught in tight racing into the first turn, raced well placed along the inside into the far turn and faded. MAX O MAX was through early.
