SWEETTRICKYDANCER unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn, angled out for the drive and rallied outside the drifting ASKFORARAISE to be up late. The latter, rated off the pace, rallied three wide on the far turn, moved to gain a slim lead at the eighth pole, then drifted out through the final eighth and held the place while unable to resist the winner. RUNNING DEBATE outrun early, swung out for the stretch run and closed with a belated rally inside ASKFORARAISE to gain the show. U K TRICK reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and finished willingly. SILVERY PET allowed to settle, saved ground around the far turn, rallied along the hedge to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. HURRY HOME stalked the pace along the inside into the stretch and tired. ROYAL DOVE chased the pace, drew even into far turn, vied with SILVERY PET to inside the eighth pole and gave way. ACTCELLENT taken in hand, was attempting to rally when caught in behind rivals and steadied in the stretch, then had no late response. HEAVENLY MISS failed to menace. CRIMSON AND ROSES set the pace along the hedge, vied with ROYAL DOVE around the far turn and into the stretch, then faltered. SNAPPY TALE was outrun after being steadied soon after the start. TUSCANY LIGHT prompted the pace outside CRIMSON AND ROSES to nearing the far turn and faded.
