Footnotes

PHILLY ACE never far back while along the inside, patiently handled inside and behind horses in the second turn, moved out three wide when an opening presented itself turning for home, finished with good late energy to prove best. HOLLINGER set the pace while in hand, dueled through the second turn, garnered a larger advantage midstretch, gave ground grudgingly to the winner late. EMPIRE BUILDER forward out of the chute, pressured the runner up in the run up the backstretch, engaged that save rival from the outside and dueled through the second turn, could not keep up in the drive, held the show. HOOFIT (NZ) reserved off the pace for six furlongs, called on for some run late in the final turn, made a late run up the hedge to be gaining for the show spot. ALLEY OOP OOP steadied early while in some traffic past the wire the first time, remained back, came four wide out of the final turn, staged a mild rally. SLEEPLESS KNIGHT in some traffic along the inside early, raced forwardly and between rivals into the far turn, lacked the needed response in the drive. GOOD BETTER BEST steadied past the wire the first time while under stout restraint, three wide trip while forwardly placed, lacked a closing kick when straightened for home. DANNHAUSER remained near the back throughout. SCORCHER off slowly, trailed most of the way in showing little.
