Footnotes

LIZARD'S REPENT dueled up front closest to the inside, shook off the other early speed into the far turn, headed soon after, set down, battled back inside, edged steadily clear. IMPERIAL POWER off a step slow, raced back early under restraint, began to advance far turn, steady gain to be up for the place while toward the inside. SLEW DEM forwardly placed off the inside, ranged up to challenge and put a head in front midway on the second turn, dueled with the winner into the stretch, could not keep up, weakened and was caught late for the place. EMPEROR'S TUNE off slowly, raced well back off the pace, trailed second turn, displayed a modest amount of late interest. IMPERIAL'S CATCH dueled up front outside the winner, was the first to blink into the far turn, continued to weaken stretch. MONSTER POMEROY off the pace, lacked a kick in the drive. STRAIGHTSUCCESS raced in mid pack early in the two path, tired in the drive. LIKE LIGHTNING within striking distance well out in the strip, pushed out four wide through the first turn, continued outside up the backstretch, four wide again in the second turn, gave way in the drive.
