QUARTERMAIN brushed at the start, raced unhurried in allowed the leaders to go into the first turn, continued back, steered out widest for the drive, in time down the middle of the strip. BRAVE APACHE broke in, pinched back foe, straightened and got clear early in the first turn, continued to set the pace by a slim margin, gave ground grudgingly in the drive while lugging out to help tighten up CHISELED LIGHT. RUN SMART ONE settled off the pace and the inside, ranged up to challenge three wide late in the final turn, came in slightly upper stretch to pressure CHISELED LIGHT slightly from the outside, raced on equal terms with the runner up past the furlong marker, hung in the late going to settle for the show. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE TRAINER OF CHISELED LIGHT AGAINST RUN SMART ONE FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. CHISELED LIGHT got out a bit when forcing the issue into the first turn, continued to press up the backstretch, was going evenly when put in tight approaching the furlong marker, failed to recover. ARTURIUS steadied when put in tight at the start, fell back to trail, four wide into the lane, trailed home in a dull effort.
