AUGUST STORM well handled while making the pace along the hedge, responded when set down for the drive and prevailed. KATHY K D reserved off the pace, raced between rivals on the far turn, angled out for the drive and rallied to be up for the place. PIANO CHIMES raced in striking position three wide throughout and closed with a mild response while being edged for the place. LUSH SOLDIER stalked the pace, made a run at AUGUST STORM on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. LUJIEEN LUJIEEN unhurried early, advanced into contention while saving ground, then lacked the needed response when set down for the drive. TRIX CITY tracked the leaders into the stretch and tired. WEEPNOMOREMYLADY up close early, eased back racing around the first turn, then failed to rally. VIVINE raced three wide and failed to menace. BARRISTER KATHLEEN was no factor after being outrun early. SOCIAL PLACE showed little. KATIE KREITZ was saving ground when checked from tight quarters on the far turn and faded.
