TIMELY TINA outrun early, rallied four wide around the far turn, moved to take over inside the eighth pole and was fully extended to prevail. WILD MARTHA well placed while saving ground, angled out in early stretch, rallied to reach even terms for command at the eighth pole but couldn't stay with the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. COOL ARIA allowed to settle, angled out in the stretch and closed to be up for the show. DUCK THE PUNT showed speed along the inside, vied with VEGAS ALARM around the far turn and into the stretch, then weakened. VEGAS ALARM chased the pace, moved to reach even terms for command racing into the far turn, vied with DUCK THE PUNT to midstretch and tired. SILVER TOUCH was taken up when she bumped hard with FRAME OF MIND soon after the start and failed to be a factor. CHAMPAGNE ON ICE chased the leaders to nearing the stretch and faltered. LOVER'S VENDETTA showed little. FRAME OF MIND bumped hard with SILVER TOUCH soon after the start and was through after a half mile.
