Footnotes

SNOWDROPS (GB) reserved early, angled to the outside at the top of the stretch and rallied under pressure to be up late. LA REINA well placed in behind the leaders, rallied along the hedge to gain the lead inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner in the closing strides. TICKER TAPE (GB) allowed to settle, rallied four wide around the far turn, reached near even terms for command in midstretch, then weakened. SAND SPRINGS off slowly, was bit rank under restraint in the early going, advanced three wide around the first turn to stalk the pace, made a run to reach the leaders in the stretch, then gave way in the drive. PATH OF THUNDER quickly moved to the fore, made the pace along the inside to past the eighth pole and tired. ELLE RUNAWAY failed to menace. SILVER LACE tracked the pace into the far turn and faltered. PATTIANO chased the pace to nearing the stretch, then faded. SKIP COMMAND raced three wide on the far turn and was not a factor.
