MR MAJOR, unhurried early, steadied on the far turn while rallying, angled outside DANCE THE BALLADO and wore that rival down in the drive. DANCE THE BALLADO stalked the pace, split rivals to gain command down the backstretch, drew clear but couldn't hold off the winner. EARL WHO set the pace along the inside and tired. CLASSICAL SKY raced wide throughout and tired. SPOONING, allowed to settle early, was no threat. KING'S JEWEL saved ground and faltered. MYSTIC CITY was no factor after breaking awkwardly. LUCKY T. V. showed little. ADMAN, wide on the first turn, raced with the pace for a half mile and gave way. TRANSVERRE showed brief speed and stopped.
