SOMETHING VENTURED rated off the pace, eased outside the leader for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. SNOWDROPS (GB) allowed to settle, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up for the place. CHANGING WORLD sprinted to a long lead along the hedge, made the pace to deep stretch and gave way. MYSTERY ITSELF unhurried early, raced three wide on the far turn and found her best stride late. HAIL HILLARY reserved off the pace, didn't do enough late. ALCHEMIST raced three wide on the far turn and failed to menace. RIGHT THIS WAY was not a factor. FORMAL MISS failed to threaten after being outrun early. LOVE STING chased the pacesetter into the stretch and tired. OMEYA (CHI) was outrun. BROADWAY LADY showed little. ANEGADA saved ground and faltered.
