**Footnotes**

LOVING THOUGHTS taken in hand early, raced three wide around the far turn and rallied to be up in the final strides. IRREVOCABLE stalked the pace, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead but couldn't resist the winner in the closing yards. JUST A LITTLE JET well placed racing along the hedge, was steadied in behind PLAN OF ATTACK on both turns, eased out for the drive and didn't do enough late while holding the show. PIPERS HONOUR rated off the pace after being steadied in the early going, was checked in traffic on the far turn, recovered and finished willingly to just miss the show. PUZZLE reserved off the pace, steadied in traffic on the backstretch and again on the far turn, then failed to threaten. FONDLY RECOMMENDED chased the pace three wide into the stretch and tired. MEGAFLEET raced four wide and failed to menace. COMEONGAL was not a factor. MORTGAGE THE HOUSE saved ground and faltered. SI TIGRE LIL off slowly, was outrun. PETITE VIE showed little. PLAN OF ATTACK showed speed along the hedge into the far turn and faded.
