WESTERN FLAIR chased the pace three wide into the stretch but couldn't get to the winner while clearly second best. AUSPICIOUS GIRL broke a step slowly, tracked the leaders into the stretch and tired. REALITY TIME showed speed along the inside into the turn and faltered. TWENTIETH OF MAY was not a factor. MISS FEAR FACTOR was done early. NOWADAYS was outrun after breaking poorly. MOHANI showed early foot and faded.
