DIXIE FLASH reserved racing along the inside, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be up late. LITTLEBITASTUFF stalked the pace along the inside, was steadied awaiting room on the far turn, rallied to gain the lead briefly at the sixteenth pole but was outfinished. RANDOM ANNIE rated off the pace, angled out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while unable to get to the top ones. NORMANS FLEET outrun early, improved her position without threatening. TWENTIETH OF MAY chased the pace, moved to take over on the far turn and opened a clear lead, then gave way in the drive. UNTUTTTABLE GAL bumped with GO DANCING GO at the start, then steadied racing into the first turn, moved out track the leaders four wide around the far turn and tired. PAGO ISLAND chased the leaders three wide into the stretch and faltered. GO DANCING GO bumped with UNTUTTTABLE GAL at the start, then steadied in the run to the first turn, raced five wide on the far turn and faded. JOYFUL JACKIE set the pace along the rail into the far turn, then had nothing left.
