OPPORTUNE MOMENT set a pressure pace for five furlongs, shook loose in upper stretch and held sway under right hand urging. HARBOR WIN was under a firm hold while saving ground, rapidly gained along the rail in upper stretch and finished willingly. PAISANO CREEK raced well back while three wide to the turn and rallied belatedly. KING MIDAS bobbled after breaking awkwardly, settled in good position, made an inside move to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. ENGINERY raced up close to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. SURELY SENT steadied along the inside on the first turn and failed to menace while saving ground. BONNISTAR raced four wide for six furlongs and tired. EURO TIGER pressed the winner from outside to the turn and gave way.
