Footnotes

HYPHEN set the pace under pressure along the inside, then drew clear in early stretch and remained clear to the wire under urging. KING COMBO unhurried early, angled out for the stretch run and rallied to be just up for the place. BROWN DIRT COWBOY chased the pace three wide, moved into the attending position leaving the turn but had no late response and was edged for the place. GREAT BLADE outrun after breaking a step slowly, passed tired rivals in the drive. DOCTOR GARRETT broke awkwardly, then failed to menace while racing three wide. B B'S SONG was not a factor. APOLLYONCOMESFIRST showed early foot and tired. NACASCOLO pressed the pace outside HYPHEN to nearing the stretch, then faltered and was vanned off after the finish. AMY'S BUDDHA well placed early, faded.
