**Footnotes**

CANNON WHIRL stalked the pace, gained a slim lead at the eighth pole and was fully extended to last over DAWN'A SEZ. The latter, unhurried early, angled out in midstretch and closed fast to just miss. MISS A. J. AVEDON showed speed along the inside and gave way grudgingly. BURNTHMUPASHLEY chased the pace three wide into the stretch but lacked a late response. ALLENDAR sluggish to begin, swung to the outside for the stretch run and improved her position. DANI MAX up close early, faltered. HANNA'S TUNE was never a factor. LADY IZ WAITIN was outrun.
