HYMN OF LOVE (IRE) stalked the pace, rallied three wide to take over at the top of the stretch and drew clear under pressure. RUSSIAN SWEETIEPIE reserved racing along the rail, eased out in the stretch and split rivals to gain the place. EXCHANGE BAY allowed to settle, swung out for the stretch run and closed to be up for the show while just missing the place. LITTLE BUTTERCUP rated in striking position off the pace, lacked a late response. MISS BRADFORD CO failed to menace. TEAK TOTEM chased the pace, made a run to reach even terms for command leaving the far turn, then tired in the drive. BLUE GRASS DANCER set the pace along the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way. SWEET LITTLE AVIE was not a factor.
