Footnotes

TARGHEE PASS reserved off the pace, angled to the outside on the far turn, rallied to take over nearing the eighth pole and opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to last over GREEN BLUFF. The latter, unhurried early, advanced into contention around the far turn, angled out for racing room in the stretch and was gaining on the winner at the finish. SCREENPLAY stalked the pace, made a run at the leaders in the stretch, then gave way. PASTERO rated off the pace, raced three wide around the far turn and had no late response while finishing on even terms with SURELY SENT. The latter, well placed early, made a run three wide to join the leaders racing into the stretch, then tired in the final eighth and dead heated with PASTERO. MR. RICO off slowly, failed to menace. ROAR OF THE SURGE chased the pace, moved to gain a slim lead on the far turn, made the pace into the stretch, then faltered. BLUEWATER CAT pressed the pace outside VEGETARIAN SOLDIER, gained a slim lead from that rival racing into the far turn, maintained that advantage to midway of the turn, then faded. LE ROYALE was done early after breaking slowly. VEGETARIAN SOLDIER set the pace along the rail into the backstretch, then had nothing left.
