Footnotes

WANDER MOM moved up to gain the early advantage, set a moderate pace while in hand for five furlongs, shook loose on the far turn, extended her lead in upper stretch then was fully extended to hold off STRAWBERRY BLONDE in the closing strides. STRAWBERRY BLONDE (IRE) raced inside leaving the first turn, moved out along the backstretch, closed a bit while behind horses midway on the turn, altered course to the outside for clear sailing leaving the turn, circled five wide into the stretch then finished strongly in the middle of the track but could not get up. BABAE (CHI) raced just off the pace while four wide for seven furlongs, took up chased after the winner in upper stretch then finished willingly to hold for a share. ABUELA ESTHER (URU) was reserved for six furlongs, launched a rally four wide on the turn, edged closer in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her rally. NEW ECONOMY raced within striking distance between rivals to the top of the stretch and finished evenly. AMELIA raced just off the pace while saving ground into upper stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. VOLGA (IRE) raced well back while saving ground, rallied along the rail to reach contention in midstretch then flattened out. QUEUE failed to threaten after breaking slowly. HALO OF TRUTH never reached contention. TWO ITEM LIMIT forced the pace from outside to the turn and tired.
