FIRST TOUR set the pace under pressure outside NICKTHEHOUSEBUSTER, then drew away through the stretch under steady urging. OROCOIPO (CHI) chased the winner three wide around the turn but was no match for that rival in the drive. NICKTHEHOUSEBUSTER forced the pace along the rail and tired. PERSIAN SPY unhurried early, passed tired rivals. ACTSPECTATIONS was bumped sharply and clipped heels at the start, rushed up into contention, then faltered. FAST SEARCH raced four wide around the turn and faded. PASSAGE EAST bobbled at the start bumping with ACTSPECTATIONS and was outrun. CASTAN (IRE) trailed.
