ICANSEECLEARLY tracked the pace, rallied to take over inside the eighth pole and drew away under urging. PROUD MEGAN chased the pace off the rail, moved to take over on the far turn but was no match for the winner while continuing on with good courage for the place. WINNIEDAWHALE unhurried early, passed tired rivals to be up for the show. STORMY SKY well placed while saving ground, tired in the drive. TECHNICAL QUESTION failed to menace. LOTTERY LUCK was not a factor. WILD BUT WORTH IT steadied at the start, rushed up to gain the lead, made the pace along the inside into the far turn and faltered. VELVETRY was done early after breaking awkwardly, then eased in the final eighth.
