ANNA'S CAUSE stalked the leader into the stretch, rallied to take over at the eighth pole and drew clear under urging. HENNIE'S MELODY stalked the pace, angled out for the drive and closed to gain the place while unable to stay with the winner. CAJUN DAWN set the pace along the inside into the stretch and gave way. DENISE'S THUNDER unhurried early, passed tired rivals without threatening. YESJAZ up close early, saved ground and tired. RACHEL'S SONG rated off the pace after stumbling and bumping with DESTINY SAY'S at the start, faltered leaving the far turn. WALKINFORKISSES was outrun. DESTINY SAY'S bumped with RACHEL'S SONG and steadied at the start, then was through early. MY BERT tracked the pace into the far turn, faded and was eased in the final eighth.
