GAMEDAY SPANKING outrun after breaking slow and being steadied at the start, raced four wide around the far turn, then rallied under pressure to be up late. LAUGHING ALLTHEWAY vied for the lead outside DEE RAY, edged away from that rival inside the eighth pole but couldn't resist the winner late. SMART SEARCH tracked the leaders three wide into the stretch and finished willingly while unable to match strides with the winner. DEE RAY vied for the lead along the inside into the stretch and gave way. CODERO was not a factor. WESTERN CONCERN was outrun after being steadied when he broke in at the start. PADDLEYOUROWNCANOE was never a threat. PHIL'S IN FRONT well placed early, faltered.
